The magic of Fjord-Norway – A voyage to Hardangerfjord and Saudafjord

Let yourself be enchanted on this heritage voyage to two of Norway's most beautiful fjords. The Nordstjernen sails deep into the well-known Hardangerfjord, one of Norway's most traditional regions. Be impressed by rugged rock faces, lush green meadows, and high waterfalls beneath the Folgefonna glacier. Then discover the gentle character of the Saudafjord. This hidden fjord gem, with narrow windings between smoothly rounded mountain peaks, can only be reached by small ships. Begin this journey either in Warnemünde or in Malmö.



The Ship

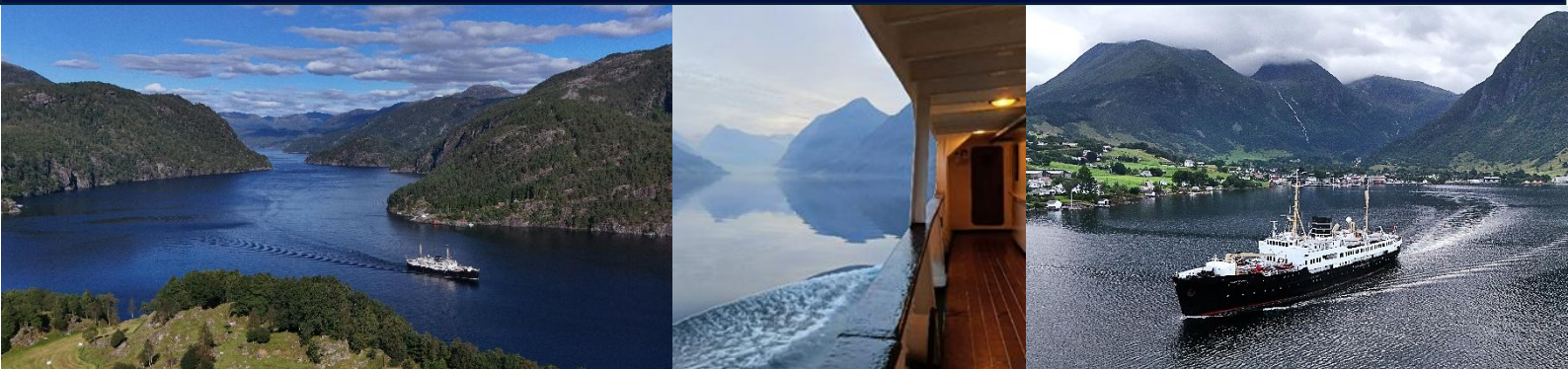
- ★ Built in 1956 at the Blohm & Voss shipyard in Hamburg
- ★ Served on the iconic Norwegian Hurtigruten coastal route for 56 years
- ★ Small ship with 80 – 110 passengers.
- ★ Simple and small cabins. Good opportunity to remember that life was simpler 40 – 50 years ago
- ★ Very cozy saloon deck and Teak planked outside decks
- ★ 2012 listed as a cultural heritage monument by the Norwegian Directorate for Cultural Heritage

1956 – 2026 70 Years Nordstjernen

On February 24, 1956, the Blohm & Voss shipyard in Hamburg handed over the MS Nordstjernen to BDS (Det Bergenske Dampskibsselskap). The Nordstjernen was transferred to Bergen and began service on the coastal express route along the Norwegian coast on March 1, 1956.



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MS Nordstjernen Travel Itinerary*

Day 1: Embarkation in Warnemünde

Your adventure begins in the picturesque harbor town of Warnemünde, the gateway to the Hanseatic city of Rostock, known for its landmarks such as the historic lighthouse and the Teepott building with its distinctive curved architecture. As you board the MS Nordstjernen in the afternoon, you immediately feel the nostalgic atmosphere of times gone by.

Day 2: Embarkation in Copenhagen/Malmö

Today, the Nordstjernen calls at Malmö, the southern Swedish city opposite Copenhagen. The old town reflects the city's diverse history. Additional travelers join us on board in Malmö. In the afternoon, enjoy the departure through the Øresund and get ready for exciting days ahead.

Day 3: Kristiansand

Today, the MS Nordstjernen docks in Kristiansand. This coastal city in the far south of Norway is known for its charming old town "Posebyen" with well-preserved wooden houses, vibrant cultural life, and a picturesque harbor. At the Fartøyvernseier, historic ships are restored, and Norway's oldest dry dock can be admired.

Day 4: Fjord Magic – Hardangerfjord

Enjoy the scenic sailing into the Hardangerfjord. By late morning, we reach Rosendal, which we visit by tender boats. Optionally, join a guided hike to the Hatteberg waterfall and to the Rosendal Barony, a small estate surrounded by large trees. In the afternoon, the MS Nordstjernen continues deeper into the fjord, passing steep mountains rising directly from the water. Meadows in the color of autumn and waterfalls create an impressive backdrop below the Folgefonna glacier.

Day 5: Fjord Magic – Hardangerfjord

Today there is time to discover Eidfjord. The village lies peacefully at the easternmost point of the fjord, surrounded by one of Norway's most beautiful landscapes. The impressive Vøringfossen waterfall rises above the village and is the destination of an optional bus excursion. Relax on board in the afternoon as the magnificent fjord panorama impresses once again during the departure from the fjord.

Day 6: Fjord Magic – Saudafjord

In the morning, we enjoy a cruise through the picturesque Saudafjord. Around every bend, a new view of the magnificent mountain landscape unfolds. A truly exclusive experience, as the Nordstjernen is the only internationally operating passenger ship to visit this enchanting fjord. We reach Sauda in the late morning. Historically, the town is shaped by a smelting plant from the early 20th century, powered by hydropower and still in operation today. The company-built workers' settlement was thoughtfully planned and remains a popular residential area. In the afternoon, the MS Nordstjernen departs Sauda for a scenic sailing southward.

Day 7: Flekkefjord

The day begins with a scenic sailing through the Listafjord to Flekkefjord, a typical southern Norwegian coastal town with many white wooden houses from the era of Dutch trade and a lively harbor. The picturesque streets invite you to take a leisurely stroll, discover street art, or relax in a sauna by the sea.

Day 8: Gothenburg

The day begins with a cruise through the archipelago before arriving in Gothenburg. The city impresses with a mix of historic old town, vibrant harbor, green parks, and fascinating museums. Some guests will leave us here, before the Nordstjernen heads south.

Day 9: Warnemünde

Today, your nostalgic journey on board the MS Nordstjernen ends in Warnemünde. Enjoy the final hours on board, take in the relaxed atmosphere, and look back on unforgettable days.

Dining onboard

Shore excursions

Warnemünde

The berth of MS Nordstjernen is **easy to reach**:

Train: About a 10-minute walk from Warnemünde station. Convenient rail connections from Hamburg and Berlin. Tickets available at [db.de](https://www.db.de).

Flight: The nearest airports are Hamburg and Berlin-Brandenburg, with onward travel by train to Warnemünde.

Copenhagen / Malmö

The berth of MS Nordstjernen is **very easy to reach**:

Train: approx. 5-10 minutes on foot from Malmö C station. Direct trains to Malmö from Oslo, Stockholm, and Denmark.

Flight: The nearest airport is Copenhagen International Airport. From there, it's a 20-minute ride on the airport shuttle train to Malmö C.
